

## Psalm 99

King James Version (KJV)

**99** The LORD reigneth; let the people tremble: he sitteth between the cherubims; let the earth be moved. (tremble- stand in awe), (Revelation-11:19 tells of the Ark between the cherubims)

<sup>2</sup>The LORD is great in Zion; and he is high above all the people.

<sup>3</sup>Let them praise thy great and terrible name; for it is holy. (terrible- awesome or revered)

<sup>4</sup>The king's strength also loveth judgment; thou dost establish equity, thou executest judgment and righteousness in Jacob. (Jacob- the 12 tribes)

<sup>5</sup>Exalt ye the LORD our God, and worship at his footstool; for he is holy. Revelation-3:9, Hebrews-1:13

<sup>6</sup>Moses and Aaron among his priests, and Samuel among them that call upon his name; they called upon the LORD, and he answered them. (all three were intercessors for Israel, with God)

<sup>7</sup>He spake unto them in the cloudy pillar: they kept his testimonies, and the ordinance that he gave them.

<sup>8</sup>Thou answeredst them, O LORD our God: thou wast a God that forgavest them, though thou tookest vengeance of their inventions. (Moses- striking the rock at Mirabah cost him and Aaron the Promised Land.) (Today – Easter is an abomination. Passover is the true holiday)

<sup>9</sup>Exalt the LORD our God, and worship at his holy hill; for the LORD our God is holy.

Ps-93, 97, 99 all begin with the same “The LORD reigneth”, and end with holiness.
