King James Version (KJV)

(Chronicles = Words of the day or Events of the times
The Greek word for Chronicles in the Septuagint means = Things omitted – implies omitted from Samuel & Kings I & II. Our word Chronicles comes from the Latin word – Chronicon)

(Chronicles – seen from God’s perspective (mostly about Judah)

(Samuel & Kings – seen from man’s perspective (Judah & Israel)

Chapters 1-9 (are Genealogies (Judah & Levi are extensive because these seed lines came together in Mary – flesh mother of Jesus – God with us <Emmanuel>) See Isaiah-7:14

1 Adam, Sheth, Enosh, (Adam= Eth-HA-Adam = The man Adam; Adam can also mean the adamic man – the descendants of the-man-Adam)

(Adam was not the first man on Earth as the churches teach. He was the first man of the genealogy of Jesus Christ)

(This Book also serves as a second witness to Genesis, Cain is not in Adams family. He was the son of Satan and Eve. His genealogy is in Genesis-4. Adam’s genealogy is here & in Genesis-5)

⁴Noah, Shem, Ham, and Japheth. (Noah & his three sons - collateral descendants) (Shem is in the lineage of Mary & Jesus) Luke-3:36

(Chapters 1-9 are all Genealogy. For events, jump to Chapter-10)

(Chapter-2:55 Documents how the Kenites infiltrated Judah, under Joshua, and became a part of the genealogy of Israel. They still are today)

⁵The sons of Japheth; Gomer, and Magog, and Madai, and Javan, and Tubal, and Meshech, and Tiras.

⁶ And the sons of Gomer; Ashchenaz, and Riphath, and Togarmah.

⁷ And the sons of Javan; Elishah, and Tarshish, Kittim, and Dodanim.

⁸ The sons of Ham; Cush, and Mizraim, Put, and Canaan.

⁹ And the sons of Cush; Seba, and Havilah, and Sabta, and Raamah, and Sabtechah. And the sons of Raamah; Sheba, and Dedan.

¹⁰ And Cush begat Nimrod: he began to be mighty upon the earth.

¹¹ And Mizraim begat Ludim, and Anamim, and Lehabim, and Naphtuhim,

¹² And Pathrusim, and Casluhim, (of whom came the Philistines,) and Caphthorim.

¹³ And Canaan begat Zidon his firstborn, and Heth,

¹⁴ The Jebusite also, and the Amorite, and the Girgashite,

¹⁵ And the Hivite, and the Arkite, and the Sinite,

¹⁶ And the Arvadite, and the Zemarite, and the Hamathite.

¹⁷ The sons of Shem; Elam, and Asshur, and Arphaxad, and Lud, and Aram, and Uz, and Hul, and Gether, and Meshech.

¹⁸ And Arphaxad begat Shelah, and Shelah begat Eber.

¹⁹ And unto Eber were born two sons: the name of the one was Peleg; because in his days the earth was divided: and his brother's name was Joktan.

²⁰ And Joktan begat Almodad, and Sheleph, and Hazarmaveth, and Jerah,

²¹ Hadoram also, and Uzal, and Diklah,

²² And Ebal, and Abimael, and Sheba,

²³ And Ophir, and Havilah, and Jobab. All these were the sons of Joktan.

----- (24-27 Back to direct seed line from Shem to Abraham)

²⁴ Shem, Arphaxad, Shelah,

²⁵ Eber, Peleg, Reu,

²⁶ Serug, Nahor, Terah,

²⁷ Abram; the same is Abraham. (Verses 4-27 - 2446 BC -> 1996 BC)

²⁸ The sons of Abraham; Isaac, and Ishmael. (Isaac son of Sarah, Ishmael son of Hagar, an Egyptian concubine of Abraham's)

(Ancestors of Arabs of today) -----

²⁹ These are their generations: The firstborn of Ishmael, Nebaioth; then Kedar, and Adbeel, and Mibsam,

³⁰ Mishma, and Dumah, Massa, Hadad, and Tema,

³¹ Jetur, Naphish, and Kedemah. These are the sons of Ishmael.

(Sons of Abraham by his second wife)-----

³² Now the sons of Keturah, Abraham's concubine: she bare Zimran, and Jokshan, and Medan, and Midian, and Ishbak, and Shuah. And the sons of Jokshan; Sheba, and Dedan.

³³ And the sons of Midian; Ephah, and Epher, and Henoah, and Abida, and Eldaah. All these are the sons of Keturah.

(Sons of Abraham by his first wife, Sarai <Sarah>; this is the genealogy of Jesus) -----

³⁴ And Abraham begat Isaac. The sons of Isaac; Esau and Israel. (Israel = Jacob, he was re-named by God) (1996 BC- 1836 BC)

(Sons of Esau)-----

³⁵ The sons of Esau; Eliphaz, Reuel, and Jeush, and Jaalam, and Korah.

³⁶ The sons of Eliphaz; Teman, and Omar, Zephi, and Gatam, Kenaz, and Timna, and Amalek.

³⁷ The sons of Reuel; Nahath, Zerah, Shammah, and Mizzah.

³⁸ And the sons of Seir; Lotan, and Shobal, and Zibeon, and Anah, and Dishon, and Ezar, and Dishan.

³⁹ And the sons of Lotan; Hori, and Homam: and Timna was Lotan's sister.

⁴⁰ The sons of Shobal; Alian, and Manahath, and Ebal, Shephi, and Onam. and the sons of Zibeon; Aiah, and Anah.

⁴¹ The sons of Anah; Dishon. And the sons of Dishon; Amram, and Eshban, and Ithran, and Cheran.

⁴² The sons of Ezer; Bilhan, and Zavan, and Jakan. The sons of Dishan; Uz, and Aran.

(43-50 – kings of Edom) -----

⁴³ Now these are the kings that reigned in the land of Edom before any king reigned over the children of Israel; Bela the son of Beor: and the name of his city was Dinhabah.

⁴⁴ And when Bela was dead, Jobab the son of Zerah of Bozrah reigned in his stead.

⁴⁵ And when Jobab was dead, Husham of the land of the Temanites reigned in his stead.

⁴⁶ And when Husham was dead, Hadad the son of Bedad, which smote Midian in the field of Moab, reigned in his stead: and the name of his city was Avith.

⁴⁷ And when Hadad was dead, Samlah of Masrekah reigned in his stead.

⁴⁸ And when Samlah was dead, Shaul of Rehoboth by the river reigned in his stead.

⁴⁹ And when Shaul was dead, Baalhanan the son of Achbor reigned in his stead.

⁵⁰ And when Baalhanan was dead, Hadad reigned in his stead: and the name of his city was Pai; and his wife's name was Mehetabel, the daughter of Matred, the daughter of Mezahab.

(The dukes of Edom) -----

⁵¹ Hadad died also. And the dukes of Edom were; duke Timnah, duke Aliah, duke Jetheth,

⁵² Duke Aholibamah, duke Elah, duke Pinon,

⁵³ Duke Kenaz, duke Teman, duke Mibzar,

⁵⁴ Duke Magdiel, duke Iram. These are the dukes of Edom.
