King James Version (KJV)

3 This know also, that in the last days perilous times shall come.
(These days are in the generation of the fig tree, at the end of this Age)

²For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy,
(People of no character or morals will become the majority. We see this today with schools outlawing Christianity. The colleges are mostly run by communist, atheist teachers. The result is a generation of greedy self-centered brats who don't care about God or anyone else)

³Without natural affection, trucebreakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce, despisers of those that are good, (Hard-hearted toward family; unnatural "love" like homosexuality)

⁴Traitors, heady, highminded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God; (Egomaniacs)

⁵Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away. Isaiah-29 (With their lips they honor God, but their hearts are far away from God. The few preachers that are left only teach traditions of men, not the Word of God)

⁶For of this sort are they which creep into houses, and lead captive silly women laden with sins, led away with divers lusts, (Houses of God – Homosexual preachers; also those who teach that Christians and muslims worship the same God. Their god is not our God)

⁷Ever learning, and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth. (Teaching traditions of men, emptiness and vanity; not the Word of God)

⁸Now as Jannes and Jambres withstood Moses, so do these also resist the truth: men of corrupt minds, reprobate concerning the faith. (Jannes and Jambres were magicians of Pharaoh) see Exodus-7 (reprobate = worthless)

⁹ But they shall proceed no further: for their folly shall be manifest unto all men, as their's also was. (their's - Jannes and Jambres) (Just as they were shown up as fools by Moses, so shall it be for these fake preachers in the end days)

¹⁰ But thou hast fully known my doctrine, manner of life, purpose, faith, longsuffering, charity, patience, (This was the example that Paul set for Timothy)

¹¹ Persecutions, afflictions, which came unto me at Antioch, at Iconium, at Lystra; what persecutions I endured: but out of them all, the Lord delivered me. (God takes care of His own)

¹² Yea, and all that will live godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution. (Christians are being persecuted by atheists, Muslims, Hindus, etc. The world has always hated Christians)

¹³ But evil men and seducers shall wax worse and worse, deceiving, and being deceived. (The evil ones will gain more and more power in the end days. Political and religious corruption will become the rule and not the exception)

¹⁴ But continue thou in the things which thou hast learned and hast been assured of, knowing of whom thou hast learned them; (Stay true to your knowledge and wisdom in God's word. They were gifts from God)

¹⁵ And that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus. (Wisdom in God's plan, not in the corrupt ways of the world)

¹⁶ All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: (It tells us how to live a good life and obtain salvation for the eternity)

¹⁷ That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works. (perfect= mature)
