

## Isaiah 35

King James Version (KJV)

**35** The wilderness and the solitary place shall be glad for them; and the desert shall rejoice, and blossom as the rose. (In the Millennium) (Roses don't grow in the desert. It will be transformed into a garden)

<sup>2</sup>It shall blossom abundantly, and rejoice even with joy and singing: the glory of Lebanon shall be given unto it, the excellency of Carmel and Sharon, they shall see the glory of the LORD, and the excellency of our God. (The earth will be a garden of paradise)

<sup>3</sup>Strengthen ye the weak hands, and confirm the feeble knees. (Comfort & strengthen people with the good news)

<sup>4</sup>Say to them that are of a fearful heart, Be strong, fear not: behold, your God will come with vengeance, even God with a recompence; he will come and save you. (This is the Second Advent when Jesus returns as the King of kings, Lord of lords. HE will punish the guilty and reward the innocent)

<sup>5</sup>Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened, and the ears of the deaf shall be unstopped. (In spiritual bodies, we see the truth. All are healthy and have total recall)

<sup>6</sup>Then shall the lame man leap as an hart, and the tongue of the dumb sing: for in the wilderness shall waters break out, and streams in the desert. (hart= a deer) (The whole earth will become fertile and lush)

<sup>7</sup>And the parched ground shall become a pool, and the thirsty land springs of water: in the habitation of dragons, where each lay, shall be grass with reeds and rushes. (parched= miraged -bad translation; the mirage will become a real pool of water) (Dragons are symbolic for the enemy. They won't be there)

<sup>8</sup>And an highway shall be there, and a way, and it shall be called The way of holiness; the unclean shall not pass over it; but it shall be for those: the wayfaring men, though fools, shall not err therein. (fools = simple ones – better translation; even simple people won't get lost, or go astray)

<sup>9</sup>No lion shall be there, nor any ravenous beast shall go up thereon, it shall not be found there; but the redeemed shall walk there: (No flesh will exist in the Millennium. Even the animals are no longer flesh)

<sup>10</sup> And the ransomed of the LORD shall return, and come to Zion with songs and everlasting joy upon their heads: they shall obtain joy and gladness, and sorrow and sighing shall flee away. (The Elect – those who remained faithful to God)
