

Jeremiah 4

King James Version (KJV)

4 If thou wilt return, O Israel, saith the LORD, return unto me: and if thou wilt put away thine abominations out of my sight, then shalt thou not remove. (Future – the abomination will be antichrist; pretending to be Jesus, returned)

²And thou shalt swear, The LORD liveth, in truth, in judgment, and in righteousness; and the nations shall bless themselves in him, and in him shall they glory.

³For thus saith the LORD to the men of Judah and Jerusalem, Break up your fallow ground, and sow not among thorns. (Cultivate fertile grounds before planting seeds; don't waste your time with people who don't want to hear the true Word of God)

⁴Circumcise yourselves to the LORD, and take away the foreskins of your heart, ye men of Judah and inhabitants of Jerusalem: lest my fury come forth like fire, and burn that none can quench it, because of the evil of your doings. (Circumcision today, is symbolic for changing your ways and accepting the Word of God. It applies to men and women. Paul taught that in many of his epistles)

⁵Declare ye in Judah, and publish in Jerusalem; and say, Blow ye the trumpet in the land: cry, gather together, and say, Assemble yourselves, and let us go into the defenced cities. (This trumpet will be the 7th trump in the end days, when Jesus returns)

⁶Set up the standard toward Zion: retire, stay not: for I will bring evil from the north, and a great destruction. (Then - it was Babylon; Future – It is speaking of Armageddon and Haman-Gog) Ezekiel-38 & 39

⁷The lion is come up from his thicket, and the destroyer of the Gentiles is on his way; he is gone forth from his place to make thy land desolate; and thy cities shall be laid waste, without an inhabitant. (The destroyer of the gentiles is Satan as antichrist)

⁸For this gird you with sackcloth, lament and howl: for the fierce anger of the LORD is not turned back from us. (These are terms of repenting and humility before God)

⁹And it shall come to pass at that day, saith the LORD, that the heart of the king shall perish, and the heart of the princes; and the priests shall be astonished, and the prophets shall wonder. (Those who live by the ways of the world will be astonished)

¹⁰Then said I, Ah, Lord GOD! surely thou hast greatly deceived this people and Jerusalem, saying, Ye shall have peace; whereas the sword reacheth unto the soul. (God didn't say there would be peace. He warned Judah over and over that they would be taken into captivity because of their idolatry. Zedekiah and his minions said there would be peace. All the false prophets in Jerusalem were preaching false peace. In the future, the antichrist will also preach world peace and deceive the gullible into worshipping him)

¹¹At that time shall it be said to this people and to Jerusalem, A dry wind of the high places in the wilderness toward the daughter of my people, not to fan, nor to cleanse, (A dry wind destroys life; a vain spirit to destroy- the antichrist)

¹²Even a full wind from those places shall come unto me: now also will I give sentence against them. (Antichrist will come upon the world to deceive. God warns us over and over and most Christians don't listen)

¹³Behold, he shall come up as clouds, and his chariots shall be as a whirlwind: his horses are swifter than eagles. Woe unto us! for we are spoiled. (he = Antichrist; along with his fallen angels and the Kenites; also the muslim army is rising. These will make up the locust army in prophecy of Revelation)

¹⁴O Jerusalem, wash thine heart from wickedness, that thou mayest be saved. How long shall thy vain thoughts lodge within thee?

¹⁵For a voice declareth from Dan, and publisheth affliction from mount Ephraim. (These two places are where Jeroboam set up the two golden calves to replace worship of God in the temple of Jerusalem) see 1Kings-12:25-33

¹⁶Make ye mention to the nations; behold, publish against Jerusalem, that watchers come from a far country, and give out their voice against the cities of Judah.

¹⁷As keepers of a field, are they against her round about; because she hath been rebellious against me, saith the LORD. (Keepers of the fields – shepherds and pastors)

¹⁸ Thy way and thy doings have procured these things unto thee; this is thy wickedness, because it is bitter, because it reacheth unto thine heart. (Speaking to Judah; false preachers and false religions have taken over. People don't know what the truth is anymore)

¹⁹ My bowels, my bowels! I am pained at my very heart; my heart maketh a noise in me; I cannot hold my peace, because thou hast heard, O my soul, the sound of the trumpet, the alarm of war. (Jesus will return at the 7th trumpet. By then, most people will have been deceived by false teachings and traditions of men)

²⁰ Destruction upon destruction is cried; for the whole land is spoiled: suddenly are my tents spoiled, and my curtains in a moment. (In one moment, when Jesus returns, the truth of God's Word will destroy all the traditions of men and false religions)

²¹ How long shall I see the standard, and hear the sound of the trumpet? (The standard is Jesus Christ; the trumpet is judgment)

²² For my people is foolish, they have not known me; they are sottish children, and they have none understanding: they are wise to do evil, but to do good they have no knowledge. (sottish = stupid – an old Anglo-Saxon word) (God sent us the Bible to learn the truth. Most Christians have never opened a Bible)

²³ I beheld the earth, and, lo, it was without form, and void; and the heavens, and they had no light. (God destroyed the first age because of Satan's rebellion and those who followed him, against God – the Katabole) See Genesis-1:2, Revelation-12, Isaiah-45:18

²⁴ I beheld the mountains, and, lo, they trembled, and all the hills moved lightly. (The movement of the tectonic plates over millions of years)

²⁵ I beheld, and, lo, there was no man, and all the birds of the heavens were fled. (No birds left, no men left)

(This was one of the many recorded mass extinctions. Ignorant preachers will tell you this was Noah's flood. It wasn't. Noah's flood was localized to Mesopotamia and only lasted 1 year. Chinese history records a great flood in the west. That was Noah's flood. That flood was caused by the land bridges collapsing in the Black Sea in Turkey and the Straights of Hormuz in Iran)

²⁶ I beheld, and, lo, the fruitful place was a wilderness, and all the cities thereof were broken down at the presence of the LORD, and by his fierce anger.

²⁷ For thus hath the LORD said, The whole land shall be desolate; yet will I not make a full end. (The end of the first age only; millions of years later, we are in the second age; in flesh bodies <temporarily> to decide to follow God or to follow Satan and the ways of the world. Once everyone goes through the flesh, we will be judged and those who make it will see the third age) See 2Peter, Hebrews-12:26-29

²⁸ For this shall the earth mourn, and the heavens above be black; because I have spoken it, I have purposed it, and will not repent, neither will I turn back from it. (It will happen)

²⁹ The whole city shall flee for the noise of the horsemen and bowmen; they shall go into thickets, and climb up upon the rocks: every city shall be forsaken, and not a man dwell therein.

³⁰ And when thou art spoiled, what wilt thou do? Though thou clothest thyself with crimson, though thou deckest thee with ornaments of gold, though thou rentest thy face with painting, in vain shalt thou make thyself fair; thy lovers will despise thee, they will seek thy life. Revelation-17 (The Kenites & fallen angels hate the harlot Babylon – these are the deceived people of the world that worship antichrist)

³¹ For I have heard a voice as of a woman in travail, and the anguish as of her that bringeth forth her first child, the voice of the daughter of Zion, that bewaileth herself, that spreadeth her hands, saying, Woe is me now! for my soul is wearied because of murderers. (This will be the birth of a new age) (murderers of the flesh - wars, abortion; murderers of souls – with false teaching and false religions)
