

**Psalm 92** A Psalm or Song for the Sabbath day  
King James Version (KJV)

**92** It is a good thing to give thanks unto the LORD, and to sing praises unto thy name, O Most High: (O Most High- Our Father- as possessor of Heaven and Earth)

<sup>2</sup>To shew forth thy lovingkindness in the morning, and thy faithfulness every night,

<sup>3</sup>Upon an instrument of ten strings, and upon the psaltery; upon the harp with a solemn sound. (sound – also can be translated – meditation)

<sup>4</sup>For thou, LORD, hast made me glad through thy work: I will triumph in the works of thy hands. (God's righteous acts)

<sup>5</sup>O LORD, how great are thy works! and thy thoughts are very deep.

<sup>6</sup>A brutish man knoweth not; neither doth a fool understand this. (brutish= stupid)

<sup>7</sup>When the wicked spring as the grass, and when all the workers of iniquity do flourish; it is that they shall be destroyed for ever:

<sup>8</sup>But thou, LORD, art most high for evermore.

<sup>9</sup>For, lo, thine enemies, O LORD, for, lo, thine enemies shall perish; all the workers of iniquity shall be scattered. (scattered- can also mean separated)

<sup>10</sup>But my horn shalt thou exalt like the horn of an unicorn: I shall be anointed with fresh oil. (horn - symbolic of power) (unicorn= wild ox – bad translation)

<sup>11</sup>Mine eye also shall see my desire on mine enemies, and mine ears shall hear my desire of the wicked that rise up against me. (my desire – was added by the English translators. It doesn't belong in the verse) (The just will see and hear the wicked destroyed)

<sup>12</sup>The righteous shall flourish like the palm tree: he shall grow like a cedar in Lebanon. (the palm tree - is seen as a life giver, as in an oasis in the desert) (In the eternity, after the wicked are destroyed)

<sup>13</sup> Those that be planted in the house of the LORD shall flourish in the courts of our God. (These are the Elect – on the Lord's Day)

<sup>14</sup> They shall still bring forth fruit in old age; they shall be fat and flourishing; (age means nothing in spiritual bodies)

<sup>15</sup> To shew that the LORD is upright: he is my rock, and there is no unrighteousness in him.

This Sabbath day refers to the Lord's Day. That 1000 year period after Christ's return at the 7<sup>th</sup> trump. Christ will rule for a thousand years with His Elect. Also, for today, Christ became our Sabbath – our rest.
