

Revelation 3

King James Version (KJV)

3 And unto the angel of the church in Sardis write; These things saith he that hath the seven Spirits of God, and the seven stars; I know thy works, that thou hast a name that thou livest, and art dead.

(Spiritually dead; this was a place of high commerce, and big money. Multi-cultural with a lot of foreign influence)

² Be watchful, and strengthen the things which remain, that are ready to die: for I have not found thy works perfect before God. (You don't want to join this church. They are too influenced by man instead of God)

³ Remember therefore how thou hast received and heard, and hold fast, and repent. If therefore thou shalt not watch, I will come on thee as a thief, and thou shalt not know what hour I will come upon thee.

⁴ Thou hast a few names even in Sardis which have not defiled their garments; and they shall walk with me in white: for they are worthy. (There are still a few faithful to Christ in this church, but not many. Those who remain faithful to God will see salvation; the rest won't)

⁵ He that overcometh, the same shall be clothed in white raiment; and I will not blot out his name out of the book of life, but I will confess his name before my Father, and before his angels.

⁶ He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches. (This word means to hear with perfect understanding – in the Greek. It loses its emphasis in the English translation)

⁷ And to the angel of the church in Philadelphia write; These things saith he that is holy, he that is true, he that hath the key of David, he that openeth, and no man shutteth; and shutteth, and no man openeth; (key of David - knowing the true Christ, from the false one, by their genealogy. Also knowing who the Kenites are and who they came from, in their ancestry. Once you know the truth, no one can mislead you)

⁸ I know thy works: behold, I have set before thee an open door, and no man can shut it: for thou hast a little strength, and hast kept my word, and hast not denied my name. (This is the second church that Jesus Christ found no fault with, because they were teaching who the Kenites are and their father, the devil)

⁹ Behold, I will make them of the synagogue of Satan, which say they are Jews, and are not, but do lie; behold, I will make them to come and worship before thy feet, and to know that I have loved thee.

(These are Kenites, pretending to be of Judah. They work with antichrist into deceiving the people of the world into believing that he is the messiah, returned) 2Thessalonians-2:1-17 (When the true Messiah returns, they are worshipping Jesus, at the feet of the Elect, who worship at the feet of Jesus. They are not worshipping the Elect)

¹⁰ Because thou hast kept the word of my patience, I also will keep thee from the hour of temptation, which shall come upon all the world, to try them that dwell upon the earth. (The hour of temptation is when antichrist pretends to be Jesus, returned. Most of the world will be convinced that he is the messiah, and will lose their salvation by worshipping him. That is called the great apostasy)

¹¹ Behold, I come quickly: hold that fast which thou hast, that no man take thy crown. (Don't let antichrist steal your salvation)

¹² Him that overcometh will I make a pillar in the temple of my God, and he shall go no more out: and I will write upon him the name of my God, and the name of the city of my God, which is new Jerusalem, which cometh down out of heaven from my God: and I will write upon him my new name. (For those who wait for the true Messiah to return, after the fake has been exposed as a fraud)

¹³ He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches. (To hear with understanding, on a spiritual level – in the Greek)

¹⁴ And unto the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write; These things saith the Amen, the faithful and true witness, the beginning of the creation of God; John-1:1

¹⁵ I know thy works, that thou art neither cold nor hot: I would thou wert cold or hot. (This is one of the worst of the churches. They stand for nothing – right or wrong; they are “all inclusive” and politically correct, instead of morally correct. They accept doctrines and teachings from anyone)

¹⁶ So then because thou art lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spue thee out of my mouth. (spue= vomit)

¹⁷ Because thou sayest, I am rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing; and knowest not that thou art wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked: (earthly riches amount to nothing in Heaven; they have no righteous works to account for; they are focused on the ways of the world)

¹⁸ I counsel thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich; and white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed, and that the shame of thy nakedness do not appear; and anoint thine eyes with eyesalve, that thou mayest see. (They need to work for God's Word and they will gain spiritual riches; they need to open their spiritual eyes, change their ways and repent) Isaiah-55:1

¹⁹ As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten: be zealous therefore, and repent. (God corrects the ones He loves to keep them on the right path; just as we do for our children)

²⁰ Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me. (God makes Himself available to all people; but they have to ask Him in. We do that by learning the Word, and doing it. It takes work on our part)

²¹ To him that overcometh will I grant to sit with me in my throne, even as I also overcame, and am set down with my Father in his throne. (God lived a perfect life in the flesh – as Jesus. He showed us how to do it, so there won't be any excuses at judgment time)

²² He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches. (The only 2 churches that made it are the two that teach the Key of David – knowing the true Messiah from the false one and his Kenite offspring. We know them by their genealogy)
